| 1. Adenozin    | <b>*SVT:</b><br>İlk doz 6 mg (IV),<br>yanıt alınamaz ise 12 mg (IV),<br>yanıt alınamaz ise bir sonraki doz 18 mg (IV). | Paroksizmal SVT'de taşikardinin sonlandırılmasında kullanılır.                         |
| 2. Adrenalin   | <b>*Anafilaksi:</b><br>0.3-0.5 mg (IM/SC)<br><br><b>*Kardiyak arrest:</b><br>Her 3-5 dk'da bir 1 mg (IV)               | Kardiyak arrest ve anafilaksi tedavisinde kritik öneme sahip bir ilaçtır.              |
| 3. Aktif kömür | 1 gr/kg (oral/OG/NG)                                                                                                   | Zehirlenmelerde etken maddenin absorpsiyonunu azaltma ya da engelleme için kullanılır. |
