SWEET SENDROMU (AKUT FEBRİL NÖTROFİLİK DERMATOZ)

Genel Bilgiler

Akut Febril Nötrofilik Dermatoz olarak da bilinen Sweet Sendromu ilk olarak 1964 yılında Robert Douglas Sweet tarafından tanımlanan nadir bir Nötrofilik Dermatoz tablosudur (1). Nötrofilik Dermatozlar, dermal nötrofil infiltrasyonu ile karakterize bir grup inflamatuvar hastalıktır. Klinik olarak ateş ve lökositozun eşlik ettiği asimetrik yerleşimli ani başlayan ağrılı, eritemeli, ödemli papül, plak veya nodüller ile karakterizedir ve histopatolojide üst dermiste vaskülit bulgularının olmadığı yoğun nötrofil infiltrasyonu patognomoniktir (2). Klinik bulguların sistemik kortikosteroid tedavisine dramatik yanıtı karakteristiktedir. Etyolojik olarak klasik, malignite ilişkili ve ilaç ilişkili 3 tipi tanımlanmıştır.

Klasik Sweet Sendromu

İdyopatik Sweet Sendromu olarak da adlandırılır ve Sweet Sendromu vakalarının çoğu bu gruptadır. Sıklıkla Üst Solunum Yolu (Streptokok) veya Gastrointestinal Sistem enfeksiyonları (Salmonella, Yersinya), İnflamatuvar Barsak Hastalıkları ve gebelik ile ilişkilendirilmiştir. Enfeksiyon ilişkili Sweet Sendromu genellikle enfeksiyondan 1-3 hafta sonra ortaya çıkar. Ayrıca İnsan İmmün

- D) İleri yaş başlangıçlı olgularda yaş ve cinsiyet uyumlu malignite taramaları önemlidir.
- E) Tedavi yanıtı mükemmeldir ve olguların takibi gereksizdir.
